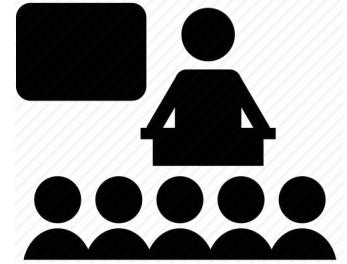

**Crawford County** has been one of Illinois' most prolific oil producing counties for more than a century. Crawford County's oil production totaled more than **776,000 barrels** in 2018, third-most in the state. Crawford County's longtime oil production has generated significant property tax revenues for the county, totaling more than **\$5.27 million** from 2007-2017. IPRB conservatively estimates that at least **\$2.63 million** of that revenue primarily went to fund the four public school districts based in the county and their combined **2,873 students**.
