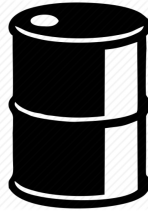

- Wabash County is a top-10 oil-producing county in Illinois at more than **400,000 barrels** per year. ¹
- Ad valorem tax revenue from Wabash County oil production generated more than **\$4.6 million** in revenue from 2007-2018. More than half of that revenue went to fund public schools. All of the revenue stayed at the local level. ²
- **More than 300 people** are directly employed in the oil production industry in Wabash County, according to a 2016 RCF Economic & Financial Consulting report, representing **8% of overall employment** in the county. ³
