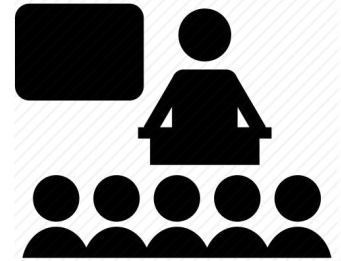

Wayne County has long been a top-10 oil producing county in Illinois, totaling [343,746 barrels](#) in 2018, seventh-most among the state's 42 producing counties. IPRB estimates Wayne County's oil production industry generated more than **\$5.85 million** in property tax revenue from 2007-2018 and conservatively estimates that at least **\$2.92 million** of that revenue primarily went to fund the county's seven primary public school districts and their combined 2,539 K-12 students.
