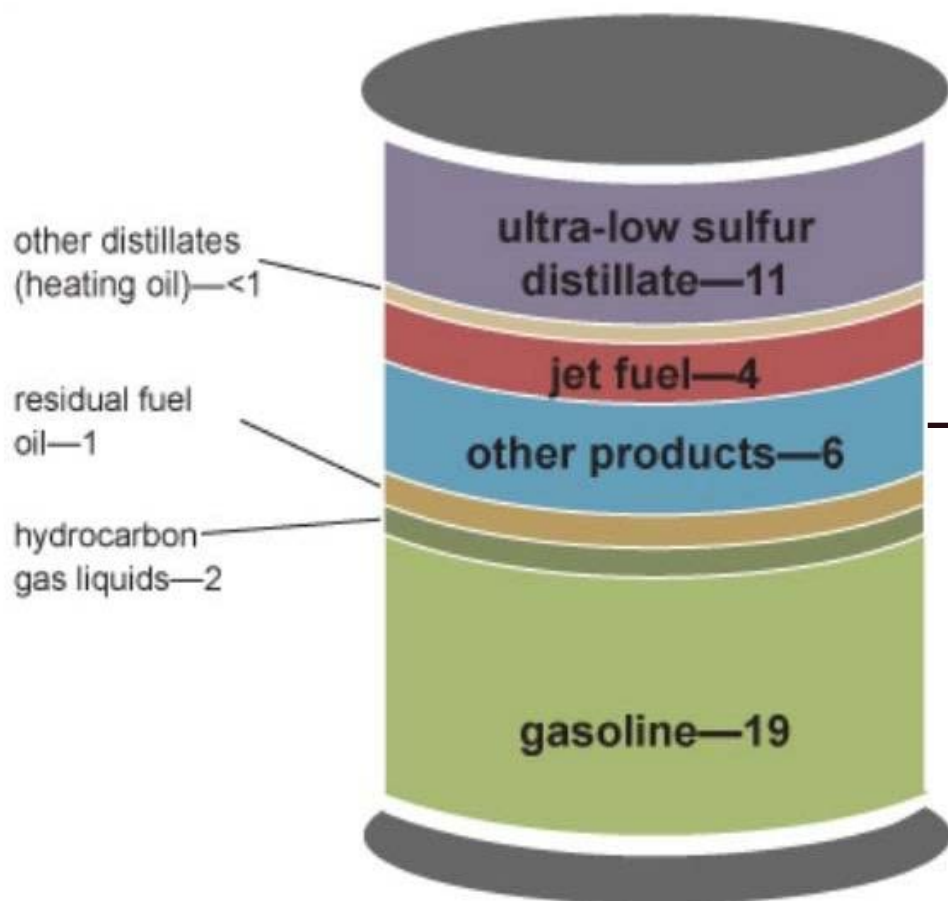


Petroleum Products Made From One Barrel of Crude Oil



Note: A 42-gallon (U.S.) barrel of crude oil yields about 45 gallons of petroleum products because of refinery processing gain. The sum of the product amounts in the image may not equal 45 because of independent rounding.

One Barrel Will Produce These "Other" Products:

- Four pounds of charcoal briquettes
- Wax for 170 birthday candles or 27 crayons
- One gallon of asphalt for roads or roofs
- One quart of motor oil
- One quart of paint thinner or dry-cleaning solvents
- Medicinal oils
- Road oil
- Plant condensates

One Barrel of Oil Provides Enough Petrochemicals to be the Base for ONE of the Following:

- 39 polyester shirts
- 750 pocket combs
- 540 toothbrushes
- 65 plastic dustpans
- 23 hula hoops
- 65 plastic drinking cups
- 195 one-cup measuring cups
- 11 plastic telephone housings
- 135 four-inch rubber balls

Other Notable Crude Oil-Based Products: N95 masks, cell phones, computers, tires.
