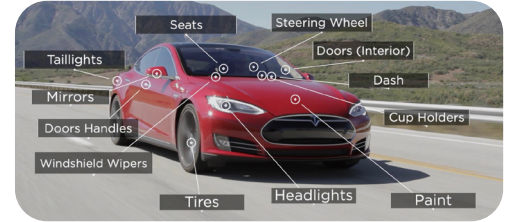


Did You Know?

The Department of Energy expects more internal combustion engine vehicles to be in used in 2050 (1.5B) than 2020 (1.2B)
